4	Iremongers Pond Update	
4.1	BA advised Environment Agency (EA) confirmed they are still going to complete reinstation works but were not able to complete all of their targets last month, partly due to nesting season. What they were able to complete was levelling the new path, spreading topsoil has been left and filling in large divets. Its currently muddy but should reseed overtime, and with their later intervention. DA and BA have complained to the EA.	
	No update on the bridge as yet.	
	Himalayan Balsam (non-native, invasive weed): a good group of Notts Wildlife Trust volunteers joined together with a handful of volunteers and council workers to mass-pick the balsam – approx. 18 attendees. Most of it has been removed, just some in the nettles. Pond side of the path completed and other side east and west of stepping stones has mainly been cleared. The remaining has gone to flower and will be very visible, just needs to be pulled up and left on the ground. It pulls up very easily.	
	JSC did some strimming in the area, needs to be cut low down.	
	DA was pursuing getting additional funding for extending the orchard. Approx. 36 trees. Good news to be shared at the next meeting.	
	There is a lime bike in the pond and a tent in the brambles. RN has reported this.
